14	Section 2	2. That § 36-15-20 be AMENDED:
15		36-15-20. The following fees promulgated in rules by the commission pursuant to
16	chapter 1-26 for all examinations, licenses, permits, and renewals required by this chapter	
17	may not exceed the following maximums amounts specified below:	
18	(1)	Examination fee which includes the and initial license fee, one hundred one
19		<u>hundred twenty-five</u> dollars;
20	(2)	Examination retake fee, one test, sixty dollars; two tests, seventy dollars; three
21		tests, eighty_ninety dollars_per examination;
22	(3)	Cosmetologist, nail technician, or esthetician license renewal fee, twenty five fifty
23		dollars;
24	(4)	Temporary cosmetologist, nail technician, or esthetician license fee, six dollars;
25	(5)	Instructor initial license fee and license renewal fee, thirty-five fifty dollars;
26	(6)	Reciprocity, initial license, and waiver of examination fee, one hundred twenty-five
27		dollars;
28	(7)	For certification Fee for a certification of a license issued under this chapter for a
29		South Dakota licensee to obtain licensure in another state, or furnishing of other
30		papers to another state or school,-twenty forty dollars;
31	(8)	Apprentice license fee, twenty five thirty dollars;
32	(9)	Apprentice salon initial license and renewal fee, two hundred fifty three hundred
33		dollars;
34	(10)	School initial license fee and renewal fee, three hundred <u>fifty</u> dollars;

1 (11)Student license fee, six fifteen dollars; 2 (12)Salon or booth initial permit license fee, sixty eighty dollars; 3 Salon or booth license renewal fee, forty sixty dollars; (13) Reinspection fee for failed salon, fifty seventy-five dollars for each reinspection; 4 (14)5 License duplicate or replacement fee, five fifteen dollars; and (15)6 (16) Fee for the inspection of a prospective salon or booth at the request of the 7 prospective applicant, seventy-five dollars per inspection. 8 Any license, permit, or renewal fee-which is collected by the commission-shall be 9 is the same for each respective license, permit, or renewal, regardless of the time 10 remaining before the expiration date.

11 Section 3. That § 36-15-20.1 be AMENDED:

12 **36-15-20.1.** The commission shall promulgate reasonable rules pursuant to, in 13 accordance with chapter 1-26, concerning the reinstatement of a lapsed licenses license 14 and a lapsed renewals required by renewal, as provided for in this chapter. The 15 commission shall by rules promulgated pursuant to promulgate rules, in accordance with 16 chapter 1-26, to establish the a fee, which that may not be no greater than twenty five 17 forty dollars for each year that the license or renewal has lapsed. The commission shall 18 also collect the fee for the license and renewal, as otherwise required by provided for in 19 this chapter.
