- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain electronic driver license reinstatement
- 2 requirements.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

- 4 Section 1. That § 32-12-43.1 be amended to read:
- 5 32-12-43.1. Any person who holds a valid South Dakota operator's license, motorcycle
- 6 operator's license, or nondriver identification card that meets the requirements of this chapter
- 7 and 6 C.F.R. Part 37, as amended to January 1, 2013 December 29, 2014, may apply by mail or

8 electronically for a replacement or updated license or identification card and a renewal once in

9 any ten year period if:

- 10 (1) The applicant is a citizen or national of the United States or is an alien who has
   permanent resident status;
- 12 (2) The applicant has not had a material change in any personally identifiable
  13 information as defined in § 32-12-1. A change of address of principal residence does
  14 not constitute a material change;
- 15 (3) The applicant is not applying for reinstatement after a suspension, revocation,

1		disqualification, or cancellation;
2	(4)	The applicant submits two forms of proof of current address;
3	(5)	In case of a renewal application only, the applicant submits a vision statement signed
4		by a licensed optometrist or ophthalmologist that supplies proof that the applicant has
5		adequate eyesight, if the applicant is sixty-five years of age or older at the time of
6		renewal; and
7	(6)	The applicant has complied with all other provisions of this chapter and is eligible
8		for renewal by mail or electronic renewal as determined by the Department of Public
9		Safety.
