## SENATE BILL NO. 43

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to criminalize the failure to report the death or 2 disappearance of a child within a specified time by certain persons responsible for the care 3 of the child. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That chapter 22-11 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as 5 6 follows: 7 Any parent, legal guardian, or caretaker who knowingly fails to notify law enforcement 8 within forty-eight hours of learning that a child, in his or her care and less than thirteen years 9 of age, is missing is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. 10 Section 2. That chapter 22-11 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as 11 follows: 12 Any parent, legal guardian, or caretaker who knowingly fails to notify law enforcement 13 within six hours of learning of the death of a minor child in his or her care is guilty of a Class
