## SENATE BILL NO. 45

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the Real Estate Commission's grounds for 2 disciplinary actions on home inspectors. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 36-21C-13 be amended to read as follows: 5 36-21C-13. The commission may refuse to grant or may suspend or revoke a home inspector 6 license or registration upon proof, to the satisfaction of the commission, that the holder has: 7 Disclosed any information concerning the results of the home inspection without the (1) 8 approval of a client or the client's representative; 9 (2) Accepted compensation from more than one interested party for the same service 10 without the written consent of all interested parties; 11 (3) Accepted commissions or allowances, directly or indirectly, from other parties 12 dealing with the holder's client in connection with work for which the holder is 13 responsible; or Failed to disclose promptly to a client information about any business interest of the 14 (4) 15 holder which may affect the client in connection with the home inspection; or

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<u>(5)</u> Been convicted, or pled guilty or nolo contendere before a court of competent 2 jurisdiction in this or any other state, or before any federal court, of a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or a felony arising under the laws of this state or under the 3 laws of the United States or any other state that would be a misdemeanor involving 4 5 moral turpitude or a felony under the laws of this state.

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
