The secretary may promulgate reasonable and necessary rules, pursuant to chapter 6 1-26, for the administration and operation of the program for adults and the elderly relating to 7 the following areas: 8 (1) Services to enable recipients to remain in their own home and services to older 9 persons in institutional and noninstitutional care; 10 (2) Legal services; 11 (3) Transportation services; 12 (4) Nutrition services; 13 Information and referral services to help the elderly gain access to programs for their (5) 14 benefit; 15 (6) Eligibility for services;

2	(8)	The basis of payment to and the qualifications for providers of services;
3	(9)	Administration of public grants, record keeping, and audit requirements;
