1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require certain wind energy facilities to include aircraft
2 detection lighting systems.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 49-41B be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

5 For any wind energy facility that receives a permit under this chapter after July 1, 2019, the
6 facility shall be equipped with an aircraft detection lighting system that meets the requirements
7 set forth by the Federal Aviation Administration for obstruction marking and lighting in Chapter
8 14 of FAA Advisory Circular (AC) 70/7460-1L, "Obstruction Marking and Lighting," dated
9 December 4, 2015. Any cost associated with the installation, operation, or maintenance of a
10 system under this section is solely the responsibility of any owner of the wind energy facility.
