- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding historical license
- 2 plates for motor vehicles.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 32-5-77 be amended to read:
- 5 32-5-77. Any person who is a resident of this state and the owner of a motor vehicle which
- 6 is more than thirty years old at the time of applying for registration of the vehicle, may apply
- directly to the secretary for a set of license plates to be described as, "historical car" motor
- 8 <u>vehicle</u> license plates in lieu of the application provided for in §§ 32-5-2 and 32-5-3. The plates
- 9 shall be issued to the applicant instead of the usual license plates after payment of a ten dollar
- 10 registration fee. The license plates shall be permanent for the life of the vehicle. Any motor
- vehicle for which historical car motor vehicle license plates have been issued shall only be used
- for special occasions such as, display, parade, exhibitions, tours, and similar uses. The vehicle
- may not be used for general transportation but may be driven to and from service stations for
- 14 fuel and repairs. Fees collected under the provisions of this section shall be credited to the state

1 motor vehicle fund. A historical motor vehicle license plate may be placed on any automobile,

2 pickup, or truck that qualifies under this section.
