## SENATE TRANSPORTATION ENGROSSED NO. **SB 72** - 1/19/2018

Introduced by: Senators Novstrup, Frerichs, and Klumb and Representatives Kaiser, Bartels, Campbell, Chase, Dennert, Holmes, Johnson, Lake, McCleerey, Schaefer, Wismer, and Zikmund

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding historical license  
2 plates for motor vehicles.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-5-77 be amended to read:

5 32-5-77. Any person who is a resident of this state and the owner of a ~~motor vehicle~~  
6 noncommercial automobile, pickup truck, van, or truck, with a weight less than eight thousand  
7 pounds, or a retired firetruck, which is more than thirty years old at the time of applying for  
8 registration of the vehicle, may apply directly to the secretary for a set of license plates to be  
9 described as, "historical ~~car~~ motor vehicle license plates in lieu of the application provided for  
10 in §§ 32-5-2 and 32-5-3. The plates shall be issued to the applicant instead of the usual license  
11 plates after payment of a ten dollar registration fee. The license plates shall be permanent for  
12 the life of the vehicle. Any motor vehicle for which historical ~~car~~ motor vehicle license plates  
13 have been issued shall only be used for special occasions such as, display, parade, exhibitions,  
14 tours, and similar uses. The vehicle may not be used for general transportation but may be



- 1 driven to and from service stations for fuel and repairs. Fees collected under the provisions of
- 2 this section shall be credited to the state motor vehicle fund.
