## SENATE BILL NO. 79

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to increase the penalty for theft of a firearm.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 22-30A-17 be amended to read:
- 4 22-30A-17. Grand theft is a Class 6 felony, if the property stolen:
- 5 (1) Exceeds one thousand dollars in value but is less than or equal to two thousand five
  6 hundred dollars;
- 7 (2) Is a firearm with a value of less than or equal to two thousand five hundred dollars;
- 8 <u>(3)</u> Is taken from the person of another with a value of less than or equal to two thousand
- 9 five hundred dollars; or
- 10 (4)(3) The property stolen is cattle, horses, mules, sheep, goats, buffalo, or captive
- nondomestic elk with a value of less than or equal to two thousand five hundreddollars.
- 13 Grand theft is a Class 5 felony if the value of the property is more than two thousand five
- 14 hundred dollars but less than or equal to five thousand dollars.



Insertions into existing statutes are indicated by <u>underscores</u>. Deletions from existing statutes are indicated by <del>overstrikes</del>. Grand theft is a Class 4 felony if the value of the property is more than five thousand dollars
but less than or equal to one hundred thousand dollars <u>or if the property stolen is a firearm</u>, <u>regardless of the firearm's value</u>.
Grand theft is a Class 3 felony if the value of the property is more than one hundred thousand dollars but less than or equal to five hundred thousand dollars.
