## SENATE BILL NO. 83

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize certain patriotic societies access to public
- 2 schools.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 13-24 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 A patriotic society shall be allowed to speak to students at each public school in the state on
- one day at the beginning of each academic school year as approved by the principal of the
- 7 school as provided by this section. The patriotic society shall provide the principal with verbal
- 8 or written notice of the patriotic society's intent to speak to the students. The principal shall
- 9 allow the representatives of a patriotic society the opportunity to speak with students during
- 10 school hours to inform the students about the civic involvement of the society, and to explain
- 11 how students may participate in or join the patriotic society.
- For purposes of this section the term, patriotic society, means a youth membership group
- or organization listed in title 36 of the United States Code, as of July 1, 2018.
