

### 2025 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 86

Introduced by: **Senator** Davis

## An Act to expand eligibility for the rural recruitment assistance program to include chiropractors and optometrists.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 34-12G-1 be AMENDED:

- 34-12G-1. The Department of Health may establish a program to assist rural
  communities in recruiting physicians, dentists, physician assistants, certified nurse
  practitioners, and certified nurse midwives the following health care professionals:
- 8 (1) Certified nurse midwives;
- 9 <u>(2) Certified nurse practitioners;</u>
- 10 <u>(3) Chiropractors;</u>
- 11 <u>(4) Dentists;</u>
- 12 <u>(5) Optometrists;</u>
- 13 (6) Physicians; and
- 14 <u>(7) Physician assistants</u>.

#### 15 Section 2. That § 34-12G-3 be AMENDED:

16 **34-12G-3.** A physician is eligible to participate in the recruitment assistance 17 program established pursuant to §§ 34-12G-1 to 34-12G-9, inclusive, if the physician is 18 licensed to practice medicine pursuant to chapter 36-4 and has completed an accredited 19 residency program in family practice, pediatrics, internal medicine, or 20 obstetrics/gynecology obstetrics and gynecology, and if the physician agrees to practice 21 in an eligible rural community for a minimum period of three years. No more than fifteen 22 physicians may participate in the program at any specified one time. Preference shall must 23 be given to physicians who have graduated from the University of South Dakota School of 24 Medicine and completed an accredited residency program-located in-South Dakota this 25 state.

A dentist is eligible to participate in the recruitment assistance program established
 pursuant to §§ 34-12G-1 to 34-12G-9, inclusive, if the dentist is licensed to practice
 dentistry pursuant to chapter 36-6A and agrees to practice general or pediatric dentistry
 in an eligible rural community for a minimum period of three years. No more than five
 dentists may participate in the program at any specified time.

6 A physician assistant, certified nurse practitioner, or certified nurse midwife is 7 eligible to participate in the recruitment assistance program established pursuant to 8 §§ 34-12G-1 to 34-12G-9, inclusive, if the physician assistant, certified nurse practitioner, 9 or certified nurse midwife is licensed to practice pursuant to chapter 36-4A or chapter 36-10 9A, respectively, and has completed an accredited physician assistant, certified nurse 11 practitioner, or certified nurse midwife program and if the person agrees to practice as a 12 primary care physician assistant, family certified nurse practitioner, or certified nurse 13 midwife in an eligible rural community for a minimum period of three years.

A certified registered nurse anesthetist is eligible to participate in the recruitment assistance program established pursuant to §§ 34-12G-1 to 34-12G-9, inclusive, if the nurse is authorized to practice the nursing specialty of nurse anesthesia, as described in § 36-9-3.1, and agrees to practice as a certified registered nurse anesthetist in an eligible rural community for a minimum period of three years.

No more than a cumulative total of fifteen physician assistants, certified nurse
 practitioners, certified nurse midwives, or certified registered nurse anesthetists may
 participate in the program at any specified time.

#### 22 Section 3. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-12G:

# A dentist is eligible to participate in the recruitment assistance program established pursuant to §§ 34-12G-1 to 34-12G-9, inclusive, if the dentist is licensed to practice dentistry pursuant to chapter 36-6A and agrees to practice general or pediatric dentistry in an eligible rural community for a minimum period of three years. No more than five

27 <u>dentists may participate in the program at any one time.</u>

#### 28 Section 4. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-12G:

- 29A chiropractor is eligible to participate in the recruitment assistance program30established pursuant to §§ 34-12G-1 to 34-12G-9, inclusive, if the chiropractor is licensed31pursuant to chapter 36-5 and agrees to a general practice in an eligible rural community32for a minimum period of three years. No more than two chiropractors may participate in
- 33 <u>the program at any one time.</u>

#### 1 Section 5. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-12G:

2 <u>An optometrist is eligible to participate in the recruitment assistance program</u> 3 <u>established pursuant to §§ 34-12G-1 to 34-12G-9, inclusive, if the optometrist is licensed</u> 4 <u>pursuant to chapter 36-7 and agrees to a general practice in an eligible rural community</u> 5 <u>for a minimum period of three years. No more than two optometrists may participate in</u>

6 <u>the program at any one time.</u>

#### 7 Section 6. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 34-12G:

8 A physician assistant, certified nurse practitioner, certified nurse midwife, or 9 certified registered nurse anesthetist is eligible to participate in the recruitment assistance 10 program established pursuant to §§ 34-12G-1 to 34-12G-9, inclusive, if: 11 (1)The physician assistant: 12 Is licensed to practice pursuant to chapter 36-4A and has completed an (a) 13 accredited physician assistant program; and 14 Agrees to practice as a primary care physician assistant in an eligible rural (b) 15 community for a minimum period of three years: 16 (2) The certified nurse practitioner or certified nurse midwife: 17 Is licensed to practice pursuant to chapter 36-9A and has completed an (a) 18 accredited certified nurse practitioner or certified nurse midwife program; 19 and 20 (b) Agrees to practice as a family certified nurse practitioner or a certified nurse 21 midwife in an eligible rural community for a minimum period of three years; 22 or The certified registered nurse anesthetist: 23 (3) 24 Is authorized to practice the nursing specialty of nurse anesthesia, as (a) 25 described in § 36-9-3.1; and 26 Agrees to practice as a certified registered nurse anesthetist in an eligible (b) 27 rural community for a minimum period of three years. 28 No more than a cumulative total of fifteen physician assistants, certified nurse 29 practitioners, certified nurse midwives, or certified registered nurse anesthetists may 30 participate in the program at any one time.

#### 31 Section 7. That § 34-12G-4 be AMENDED:

34-12G-4. A physician-or, dentist, chiropractor, or optometrist who fulfills the
 requirements of the recruitment assistance program established pursuant to §§ 34-12G 1 to 34-12G-9, inclusive, is entitled to receive an incentive payment in an amount equal
 to twice the University of South Dakota School of Medicine resident tuition for the four
 most recently completed academic years.

6 A physician assistant, certified nurse practitioner, or certified nurse midwife, or 7 <u>certified registered nurse anesthetist</u> who fulfills the requirements of the recruitment 8 assistance program established pursuant to §§ 34-12G-1 to 34-12G-9, inclusive, is 9 entitled to receive an incentive payment in an amount equal to twice the University of 10 South Dakota resident tuition for physician assistant studies for the three most recently 11 completed academic years.

#### 12 Section 8. That § 34-12G-5 be AMENDED:

13 **34-12G-5.** Any agreement for the payment of <u>A</u> rural community participating in 14 the recruitment assistance pursuant to §§ 34-12G-1 to 34-12G-9, inclusive, shall obligate 15 the rural community to be served by a physician, dentist, physician assistant, certified 16 nurse practitioner, or certified nurse midwife to <u>must</u> provide a portion of the total amount 17 of the incentive payment <u>for the health care professional who agrees to serve the</u> 18 <u>community</u>, based on the following criteria:-communities

- <u>(1) A community</u> of two thousand five hundred persons or <u>less fewer</u> shall provide
  twenty-five percent of incentive payments; <u>communities</u>
- 21 (2) A community of more than two thousand five hundred persons and less fewer than
  22 five thousand persons shall provide fifty percent of incentive payments; and all
  23 remaining eligible communities
- 24 (3) A community of more than five thousand persons shall provide seventy-five
  25 percent of incentive payments.

26 When the rural community certifies to the secretary of health that it has paid the 27 full amount for which it is obligated, the secretary of the Department of Health shall pay 28 to the physician, dentist, physician assistant, certified nurse practitioner, or certified nurse 29 midwife health care professional the remaining balance of the total incentive payment 30 amount. The secretary shall pay the required amount out of funds appropriated by the 31 Legislature for <u>such that</u> purpose. The incentive payment <u>shall must</u> be paid upon 32 completion of the required three-year practice period by the physician, dentist, physician assistant, certified nurse practitioner, or certified nurse midwife health care professional. 33

- 1 However, a <u>A</u> community may pay its portion of the incentive payment at any time during
- 2 the three-year period.
