## SENATE BILL NO. 88

Introduced by: The Committee on Transportation at the request of the Office of the Governor

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions regarding  
2 traction engines operated over bridges.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-19-4 be repealed.

5 ~~— 32-19-4. No traction engine shall cross any bridge, crossing, or culvert in the public highway~~  
6 ~~or street unless sound and strong planks not less than one foot wide and three inches thick be~~  
7 ~~placed and kept continuously under the wheels. No traction engine having mud lugs, ice spurs,~~  
8 ~~spikes, or chains attached to its wheels shall be moved over any bridge, culvert, or street~~  
9 ~~crossing, or along or over any graded or improved road surfaced with oil, gravel, macadam,~~  
10 ~~concrete, asphalt, or bitumen, without planking as provided in this section.~~

11 ~~— The provisions of this section shall not apply to threshing machine engines or tractors when~~  
12 ~~traveling upon the highways other than paved or hard surfaced highways in the regular course~~  
13 ~~of moving to and from the place of operation, except as it applies to the crossing of bridges and~~  
14 ~~culverts.~~

15 ~~— Any person who violates any of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a Class 2~~



1 misdemeanor.
