- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to continue a math pilot project at the South Dakota School
- 2 of Mines and Technology, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. Not withstanding §§ 13-13-88 and 13-13-89, there is hereby appropriated the sum
- of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, in
- 6 other fund expenditure authority, to the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology, payable
- 7 from funds derived from the workforce education fund created in § 13-13-88, for the
- 8 continuation of the 2015 math pilot project at the South Dakota School of Mines and
- 9 Technology.
- Section 2. The president of the School of Mines and Technology shall approve vouchers and
- the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

- Section 4. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 2 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 3 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
