## SENATE BILL NO. 93

Introduced by: Senators Rhoden, Brown, Gray, Maher, Olson (Russell), and Peters and Representatives Turbiville, Cronin, Juhnke, and Rausch

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize an organization to contribute to a political
- 2 action committee and to set a limit on contributions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 12-27-9 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 12-27-9. If the contributor is a person or an organization, no political action committee may
- 6 accept any contribution which in the aggregate exceeds ten thousand dollars during any calendar
- 7 year. A political action committee may accept contributions from any candidate campaign
- 8 committee, political action committee, or political party. A violation of this section is a Class
- 9 1 misdemeanor.
- Section 2. That § 12-27-18 be amended to read as follows:
- 11 12-27-18. No organization may make a contribution to a candidate committee, political
- 12 action committee, or political party. An organization may make a contribution to a ballot
- 13 question committee organized solely for the purpose of influencing an election on a ballot
- 14 question and independent expenditures regarding the placement of a ballot question on the ballot
- or the adoption or defeat of a ballot question. Any organization making expenditures, equal to

- 1 or exceeding fifty percent of the organization's annual gross income, for the adoption or defeat
- 2 of a ballot measure is a ballot question committee. An organization may create a political action
- 3 committee. A violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
