- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise provisions related to human trafficking.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 22-49-1 be amended to read as follows:
- 4 22-49-1. No person may recruit, harbor, transport, provide, or obtain, by any means, another
- 5 person knowing that force, fraud, or coercion will be used to cause the person to engage in
- 6 prostitution, forced labor, or involuntary servitude. Nor may any person benefit financially or
- 7 by receiving anything of value, including services, from participation in a venture that has
- 8 engaged in acts set forth knowingly participating in one or more of the acts described in this
- 9 section for the purposes described therein. Any violation of this section constitutes the crime
- 10 of human trafficking.
- 11 Section 2. That § 22-49-2 be amended to read as follows:
- 12 22-49-2. If the acts or the venture set forth in § 22-49-1:
- 13 (1) Involve committing or attempting to commit kidnaping;
- 14 (2) Involve a victim under the age of sixteen eighteen years;

- 2 (4) Result in the death of a victim;
- 3 any person guilty has committed human trafficking in the first degree, which is a Class 2 felony.
- 4 Section 3. That § 22-49-3 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 22-49-3. A person is guilty of human trafficking in the second degree if that person:
- Recruits, harbors, transports, provides, or obtains, by any means, another person knowing that force, fraud, or coercion will be used to cause the person to engage in prostitution, forced labor, or involuntary servitude; or
- 9 (2) Benefits financially or by receiving anything of value from participation in a venture
  10 that has engaged in acts set forth in this section, including services, and has
  11 knowingly participated in one or more of the acts described in subdivision (1) for the
  12 purposes described therein.
- Human trafficking in the second degree is a Class 4 felony.
