## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Honoring the memory and accomplishments of President  
2 Grover Cleveland.

3 WHEREAS, Grover Cleveland was the Mayor of Buffalo, New York, and the Governor of  
4 New York before becoming the President of the United States in 1885; and

5 WHEREAS, President Cleveland is the only person who has served two, non-consecutive  
6 terms as President of the United States, and President Cleveland won the popular vote for  
7 president three consecutive times; and

8 WHEREAS, President Cleveland became the first President of the United States to be  
9 married in the White House, taking Frances Folsom as his bride on June 2, 1886; and

10 WHEREAS, President Cleveland was a person of unquestioned financial integrity and  
11 honesty during his terms in the White House; and

12 WHEREAS, President Cleveland signed the bill authorizing the admission of the State of  
13 South Dakota into the union in 1889:



1       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Ninety-Third Legislature  
2 of the State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that the South  
3 Dakota Legislature honors the memory and accomplishments of President Grover Cleveland,  
4 and does hereby recognize his involvement with the admission of South Dakota into the union  
5 of states known as the United States of America.
