1 A JOINT RESOLUTION, Proposing a constitutional amendment to provide that the
2 fundamental right of state citizens to bear arms cannot be infringed and is subject to strict
3 scrutiny.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE
5 OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

6 Section 1. That at the next general election held in the state, the following amendment to
7 Article VI, section 24 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, as set forth in section
8 2 of this Joint Resolution, which is hereby agreed to, shall be submitted to the electors of the
9 state for approval.

10 Section 2. That Article VI, section 24 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, be
11 amended to read as follows:



1 § 24. The fundamental right of the citizens to bear arms in defense of themselves and the
2 state shall not be ~~denied~~ infringed.
