FISCAL NOTE

HB 7

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes any candidate for public office in this state to use unexpended fund contributions which remain after the election for reimbursement of childcare expenditures incurred by the candidate as a direct result of such candidate's participation in campaign-related events and activities, and that would not exist without the candidate's candidacy. Establishes that the use of unexpended fund contributions for the valid reimbursement of childcare expenditures does not constitute a disbursement of funds for a candidate's personal use.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The authorization enabled by this legislation involves the use of unexpended funds made available to a candidate for public office as provided from non-public entities; therefore, this legislation is estimated to have no significant fiscal impact on state or local government.
