SUMMARY OF BILL: Designates the visitor center of the Tipton-Haynes Historic Site as the “Penny McLaughlin Education and Museum Center”.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Revenue - \$1,000/One-Time/Tennessee Historical Commission

Increase State Expenditures - \$1,000/One-Time/Tennessee Historical Commission

Assumptions:

- The cost of the manufacturing and installation of signs to designate the facility as the “Penny McLaughlin Education and Museum Center” shall be paid for by the Tennessee Historical Commission (Commission).
- Before any such payments are made by the Commission, the Tipton-Haynes Historical Association shall pay the total cost of such manufacturing and installation to the Commission, pursuant to the requirements of the proposed legislation.
- Based on previous signage erected within the standards of the Commission, the one-time state expenditure is estimated to be \$1,000.
