**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 137 – HB 127**

March 18, 2017

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Increases, from 21 to 25 years, the age requirement for a person's eligibility to receive a school bus endorsement on a driver license; however, excludes existing endorsement holders between the ages of 21 and 25 years of age.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- It is assumed that a school bus driver will receive the same starting salary at any age.
- Nothing in the legislation prohibits any local education agency or school bus company from hiring additional drivers.
- The Department of Safety confirms this legislation will not impact the number of school bus endorsements issued on a driver license.
- The legislation is not anticipated to significantly impact state or local government.
