SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Extends the termination date of the Health Services and Development Agency (HSDA) to June 30, 2019. Under the *Tennessee Governmental Entity Review Law*, the HSDA is scheduled to terminate on June 30, 2017. Requires the HSDA to update the Government Operations Joint Evaluation Committee on Education, Health, and General Welfare by September 21, 2017, on the agency's progress in complying with Public Chapter 1043 of 2016.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (003674): Deletes and replaces language in Section 2 of the bill such that the termination date of the HSDA shall be extended to June 30, 2020, rather than June 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- This bill continues an existing entity at its current funding level.
- According to the Governor's Recommended Budget Document for FY17-18 (page B-153), total recommended funding for HSDA for FY17-18 is \$1,105,000 (\$1,105,000 state).
