FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 223 – HB 293

February 22, 2017

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Authorizes antique motor vehicles to be used for general transportation on federal holidays.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004023): Deletes and replaces language of the original bill without making any substantive changes to the legislation.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Under current law, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-4-111(b)(1)(C), antique motor vehicles are authorized to be used for general transportation only on weekends.
- Authorizing such use on federal holidays will not impact the number of antique motor vehicle registrations in the state.
