SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires electric power suppliers to adopt safety standards published in the August 2016 edition of the American National Standard Electrical Safety Code (ANSESC), and revises the address for the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, Inc, the entity that prepares and publishes the safety standards.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- All electric power suppliers currently adhere to the 2011 edition of the ANSESC, which is updated every five years.
- Adoption of these regularly updated safety standards will not result in any significant fiscal impact to state or local government.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- There will be no significant impact to commerce or jobs as a result of electric power suppliers adopting updated safety standards.
