FISCAL NOTE

HB 426 - SB 508

February 9, 2023

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Commissioner of the Department of Education (DOE) to report certain student testing and median household income information to the Education Committee of the Senate and the Education Administration Committee of the House of Representatives.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation will require DOE to produce two new yearly reports for committees in the legislature, which include:
 - The average performance level rating achieved by students on the most recently administered Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program by December 1 of each year; and
 - The average performance level ratings achieved by students on the most recent assessment administered to Tennessee students by the National Center for Education Statistics for purposes of the National Assessment of Educational Progress no later than 60 days after the National Assessment of Educational Progress is publicly issued.
- The department will be able to collect the necessary data and publish the required reports within existing resources, without a significant increase in state expenditures.
