**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 681 - SB 1256**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires that each hour spent by a student volunteering with the Keep Tennessee Beautiful program to count as one hour of community service credit for the purpose of qualifying for the Tennessee Promise Scholarship award.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- According to information provided by the Tennessee Promise Scholarship website [www.tnpromise.gov](http://www.tnpromise.gov), Tennessee Promise Scholarship recipients are required to complete and submit eight hours of community service each semester to maintain eligibility for the Tennessee Promise Scholarship award.
- Allowing students to count each hour spent volunteering with the Keep Tennessee Beautiful program as one hour of community service towards the eight hour requirement is not anticipated to result in a significant change in the number of Tennessee Promise Scholarship recipients.
- Based on the information provided by the Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation, this change will not require additional computer programming to the Tennessee Promise student portal.
