HB 682 - SB 1026

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the Ryman Auditorium in Davidson County to submit a drawing of the premises where alcoholic beverages may be consumed.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- This legislation only applies to one entity located in Nashville, Davidson County.
- According to the Alcoholic Beverage Commission, the Ryman Auditorium already has a historic performing arts center license, and under the proposed legislation, the same license is authorized to be held; therefore, it is estimated that there will be no fiscal impact from this entity changing its license.
- Because alcohol is already sold and consumed at the Ryman Auditorium, it is estimated that there will be no significant increase in the sale of alcoholic beverages, and no significant increase in the corresponding liquor-by-the drink and sales tax revenue from the sale of such alcoholic beverages.
