HB 769 - SB 1187

February 21, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Changes, from October 31 to October 1, the deadline for the Department of Education (DOE) and the Department of Health (DOH) to provide the joint annual report of self-administered medications and health care procedures, including administration of medications to students in public and nonpublic schools, to the Governor and General Assembly.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- DOE and DOH will be able to comply with the proposed legislation using existing resources without a significant increase in state expenditures.
- DOE and DOH will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
