HB 788 - SB 1251

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Revises various obsolete provisions under Tenn. Code Ann. Title 49 relating to education. Transfers certain responsibilities from the Department of Education (DOE) and the State Board of Education to local education agencies (LEAs). Removes and revises various duties of the Commissioner of Education.
