HB 788 - SB 1251

March 2, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Revises various obsolete provisions under Tenn. Code Ann. Title 49 relating to education. Transfers certain responsibilities from the Department of Education (DOE) and the State Board of Education to local education agencies (LEAs). Removes and revises various duties of the Commissioner of Education.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Based on information provided by the DOE the various education provisions related to this legislation removes outdated and obsolete sections of code and adds clarifying language to current practices; therefore there is no significant impact to the DOE or LEAs.
- Local boards of education and LEAs will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business without any significant fiscal impact.
