HB 934 - SB 1190

SUMMARY OF BILL: Makes various changes to the procedures established within the *Professional Educators Collaborative Conferencing Act of 2011*.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Tennessee Code Annotated § 49-5-602 defines collaborative conferencing as a process by which the chair of a board of education and the board's professional employees meet to discuss and to exchange information, opinions and proposals on matters relating to the terms and conditions of professional employee service.
- Establishing different procedures will not significantly impact local boards of education and professional employees who participate in collaborative conferencing. Any fiscal impact will be not significant.
