SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires a landlord to inspect vacated properties for abandoned animals within 72 hours of the property being vacated and notify applicable agencies if an abandoned animal is discovered.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Landlords must notify locally-owned or privately-owned animal shelters when an abandoned animal is discovered on vacated property.
- Such agencies are currently notified when abandoned animals are discovered; therefore, any fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:
