FISCAL NOTE

SB 636 - HB 1096

March 30, 2023

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits public schools, including public charter schools, from using public funds to join, become members of, or maintain membership in an association that regulates interscholastic athletics unless the association's bylaws meet certain criteria pertaining to home school student participation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Local education agencies already allow home school students to participate in interscholastic athletics.
- The proposed legislation requires home school students to automatically make a team if certain conditions are met. While this may increase home school students on teams, the number of additional students is estimated to be low, such that the increase can be accommodated within existing resources. Any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
