SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Authorizes any all-terrain vehicle operation on a certain segment of State Route 116 in Anderson County.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (005343): Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Authorizes any all-terrain vehicle operation on certain segments of State Route 116 in Anderson County.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- Based on information from the Department of Safety, there will not be a sufficient number of violations for unauthorized use of all-terrain vehicles for state or local government to experience any significant increase in revenue or expenditures.
