FISCAL NOTE

HB 1211 – SB 1075

April 3, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires a minimum 12-month wait period following departure from departmental service before a Commissioner or Deputy Commissioner is authorized to seek or accept employment with a private business entity that contracted with the Department during the Commissioner's or Deputy Commissioner's tenure of service. Authorizes the Tennessee Ethics Commission to assess a maximum civil penalty of \$10,000, if a former Commissioner or Deputy Commissioner knowingly violates this section.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Based on information provided by the Secretary of State (SOS), there will not be a sufficient number of violations for state government to experience any significant increase in fine revenue or expenditures.
- The proposed legislation will not have a significant impact on the procedures or processes of the SOS or the Tennessee Ethics Commission; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
