FISCAL NOTE

SB 330 – HB 1244

February 22, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Changes, from two to one, the number of times per school week that a local education agency (LEA) must require each student in an elementary school to participate in a physical education (P.E.) class.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Other Fiscal Impact – Some LEAs may be able to decrease their number of P.E. teachers resulting in a permissive decrease in local expenditures. The extent and timing of any such impacts cannot be determined.

Assumptions:

- LEAs are funded for elementary school P.E. teachers at a ratio of 1:350.
- No change to the minimum number of minutes of P.E. required in a week.
- Some LEAs may be able to reduce the number of P.E. teachers needed if the number of classes required decreases; however, due to several unknown factors, any precise impact to LEAs cannot be reasonably determined.
- No change to the Basic Education Program (BEP).
