**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires, by no later than July 1, 2026, the Office of the Attorney General and Reporter (AG) to submit a report on the number of investigations into consumer protection violations that involved the use of artificial intelligence and occurred in 2024 or 2025. Requires the AG to submit the report to certain members of the General Assembly and to conduct the report using existing resources.
