SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Board of Dentistry (Board) to submit a semi-annual, rather than annual, report of its proceedings and activities to the Governor.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The Board can submit an additional report under the provisions of the legislation within existing resources; therefore, no fiscal impact to state or local government.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all health-related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Board had an annual surplus of \$115,375 in FY18-19, an annual deficit of \$107,912 in FY19-20, and a cumulative reserve balance of \$4,136,500 on June 30, 2020.
