SUMMARY OF BILL: Reduces from three-fourths to two-thirds the number of qualified voters who are required to approve the contraction of municipal boundaries in an election on the question.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Reducing the number of voters who are required to approve the contraction of municipal boundaries will not have a significant fiscal impact on local government.
- Subsequent fiscal impacts to local government would be dependent on the outcome of individual de-annexation elections which cannot be forecasted.
