FISCAL NOTE

SB 661 – HB 1306

February 8, 2023

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires an entity that requires on-site payment for services and only accepts payment by quick response code (QR) or a credit or debit card machine, to accept payment by cash, by check, or through a system that allows the consumer to provide the consumer's credit or debit card information over the phone, or allow the consumer to leave the property without payment at the time, if the QR code or credit or debit card machine fails to operate correctly to process the payment transaction.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Any impact resulting from the proposed legislation will be borne by private parties.
- The proposed legislation will not significantly impact courts' caseloads.
- Any fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.

- Any impact to commerce or jobs in Tennessee is estimated to be not significant.
