FISCAL NOTE

HB 1325 - SB 1508

March 28, 2021

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Office of Research and Education Accountability (OREA) to study Title I public high schools that offer driver education courses and report the findings and conclusions of the study to Education Committee of the Senate and the Education Administration Committee of the House of Representatives by January 15, 2022.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed language requires OREA to collaborate with the Department of Education, the Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation, the Department of Labor and Workforce Development, and the Department of Human Services when conducting the study on driver education courses.
- OREA will be able to study and report on Title I public high schools that offer driver education courses during the normal course of business and within existing resources. Any impact is estimated to be not significant.
