FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1529 – SB 1645

February 6, 2018

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Authorizes a sheriff, constable, or private process server to complete a service of process in any juvenile court proceeding.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (012746): Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Authorizes any individual authorized to serve process under the Rules of Civil Procedure or the Rules of Juvenile Procedure, including, but not limited to, a sheriff, constable, or private process server to complete a service of process for juvenile court proceedings.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Passage of this legislation will have no effect on policies or procedures of the Department of Children's Services; therefore, any fiscal impact to DCS is not significant.
- No fiscal impact on the operations of court clerks, sheriffs, constables, private process servers, or any other individual authorized to serve process under the specified procedures.
