SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires State Board of Education (SBE) rules regarding appeals of certain third grade retentions to stipulate appeals must be filed by the student's parent or guardian. Requires a local education agency (LEA) or public charter school to provide a student's parent with certain information related to mandatory retention for a student in grades kindergarten through three (K-3) that is identified as having a significant reading deficiency.

• SBE, LEA's, and public charter schools will be able to amend their rules and policies within existing resources during the normal course of business such that the impact to state and local expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
