SB 1581 - HB 1666

January 31, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes a court to transfer a juvenile under the age of 14 at the time of the alleged conduct that is charged with certain offenses to criminal court to be tried as an adult.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 37-1-134(a)(1)(A)(i), the court is authorized to transfer a juvenile under the age of 14 at the time of the alleged conduct over to criminal court if the juvenile is charged with:
  - First degree murder;
  - Attempted first degree murder;
  - Second degree murder; or
  - Attempted second degree murder.
- The proposed legislation adds the following offenses to those which a court is authorized to transfer a juvenile under the age under 14 at the time of the alleged conduct over to criminal court:
  - Rape;
  - Aggravated rape;
  - Rape of a child; or
  - Aggravated rape of a child.
- Any impact to the court system, the Department of Children's Services, or state or local incarceration resulting from the proposed legislation is estimated to be not significant.
