FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 1765 - HB 1916

March 15, 2022

SUMMARY OF BILL AS AMENDED (015861): Prohibits a state agency from requiring, as a condition of eligibility for hire, an applicant to have obtained a baccalaureate degree, if the position for hire doesn't require knowledge, skills, or abilities that can only be reasonably obtained, as determined by the appointing authority, through a course of study culminating in the rewarding of such degree.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL AS AMENDED:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- This legislation may open up certain state positions to job applicants which would not have been eligible for such positions in the absence of this legislation; however, any impact upon the state is estimated to be not significant.
