FISCAL NOTE

HB 1994 - SB 2228

February 2, 2024

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes an appointed guardian or conservator to file a motion to transfer the guardianship or conservatorship from the court making the appointment to a court in another county. Establishes conditions and process for such a transfer. Establishes a maximum fee for filing of motions in such cases.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation will not impact the total number of conservatorships or guardianships in Tennessee.
- Any increase in the number of hearings in local courts is assumed to be minimal and absorbable within existing judicial resources.
- The legislation caps the fee for filing a motion or petition in such cases at \$18.
- Any revenue derived from such fees is assumed to offset equally the administrative burden and expenses of the courts and is otherwise estimated to be not significant.
- Any fiscal impact to state or local government is therefore estimated to be not significant.
