FISCAL NOTE

SB 1919 - HB 2025

March 5, 2022

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the wage rate paid by the Department of Children's Services (DCS) to each service provider with whom DCS contracts to provide care or services for children to be adjusted to reflect the average percentage pay increase provided for state employees by the general appropriations act.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- According to information provided by DCS, current contracts with service providers do not include a specific wage rate; therefore, no rate changes will occur as a result of this legislation.
- If future contracts with service providers contain language of certain and specified wage rates, this legislation may impact state expenditures.
- The proposed legislation does not require DCS to amend their contracts to include a wage rate.
- Any fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
