FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 1803 - HB 2033

March 10, 2020

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires each state agency, on or before December 1 of each year, to submit a written report to the Clerks of the Senate and the House of Representatives to be submitted to all members of the Finance, Ways and Means Committees of the Senate and the House of Representatives, summarizing the amount of funds allocated from federal block grants or other federal funds in the preceding fiscal year and purposes for which funds were expended, including any unexpended or returned amounts.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (016758): Deletes and rewrite all language after the enacting clause such that the only change is requiring the written report to be submitted on or before February 1 of each year instead of December 1 of each year.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- State agencies can submit the required written report to the Clerks utilizing existing resources without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
