HB 2046 - SB 2044

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Director and Assistant Directors of the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) to submit conflict of interest disclosures to the Tennessee Ethics Commission.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Tennessee Code Annotated § 8-50-501 requires certain public officials disclose conflicts of interest and submit those in writing to the Tennessee Ethics Commission within 30 days of being elected or appointed to the position.
- The proposed legislation would require the Director and Assistant Directors of the TBI to submit conflict of interest disclosure statements in writing to the Tennessee Ethics Commission within 30 days of being appointed as director or assistant director.
- The TBI and the Tennessee Ethics Commission confirm that the proposed legislation will not significantly impact their current policies or operations.
