HB 2190 - SB 2538

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from three to four, the number of enrolling board members the Governor may appoint in lieu of a county assessor to make enrollments of persons subject to military duty or to draft into military service.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Tennessee Code Annotated § 58-1-301 authorizes the Governor to call the militia into active service at any time that public safety requires. To that end, the Governor is authorized to “have enrollment made of all persons of this state subject to military duty or draft into the military service” and “to cause each county assessor to make such enrollment of the assessor’s respective county.”
- In lieu of a county assessor, the Governor may appoint an enrolling board to make such enrollments. Tennessee Code Annotated § 58-1-301 authorizes the Governor to appoint three members to the enrolling board. The proposed legislation increases the members of the enrolling board to four.
- The Department of the Military is not aware of any instance of the Governor appointing such enrolling boards and it is assumed that the Governor will not need to appoint any such enrolling boards in the near future.
- It is assumed that the proposed legislation will not significantly impact state or local expenditures or operations.
