SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes candidates for public office and political campaign committees to file a required report detailing all contributions received by the candidate or committee by email with the Registry of Election Finance or county election commission, for state and local elections, respectively.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 2-10-105(h), candidates for public office and political campaign committees are authorized to file a required report detailing all contributions received by the candidate or committee with the Registry or county commission by telegram, facsimile machine, hand delivery, or overnight mail delivery.
- Authorizing the report to be delivered by email, in addition to the existing methods, will have no significant impact to policies or procedures of the Registry or county election commissions.
- No significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
